2 Previous minutes & Actions (13/4/13)

- Survey – **Palenque**

- Asset Register: **John W.** to send Pat the current Asset Register

3 Treasurers Report

- Membership #'s: 35: one more than last year
- ~\$2000 each in two accounts, i.e. ~\$4000 total
- cash flow : okay, not great, John & Eve donating teaching payments back to the group (increasing income) there are a number of cross-financial year payments and disbursement of grant money that make the figures look worse.

4 Teaching

- Remainder of 2013: - changes include Jenny C teaching for Saturdays in July (After Andre). Palenque teaching Saturday 29 June.
- Palenque teaching 'Medieval' dances at the Waldorf/Steiner school to Year 7's over 3 sessions in the next 2 months.
- National Folk Festival 2014 application(s) – 17-21 April
 - Applications for two workshops as per last two Fairbridge workshops: Games people Dance and Dance Recycling Workshop, a Eurodance with Last Five Coins & Soulieado and 2xcajun workshops: People involved: Palenque, Jennifer, Jenny, John W. putting in application. Bev & Pat will also be involved if it fits around Soulieado commitments
- Fairbridge – 25-27 April – application to be put in

5 Performance Group

Proposal to aim to get a childrens performance group going to perform at a local event – perhaps the OzConcert or Fairbridge. The Committee endorsed **Palenque** to go ahead and organize if interest can be rustled up.

- Beginners Course – debrief: 3 attendees at the one session held. One was a friend of a member, another found us on the internet and the third saw the article in the Post. Another 3 rang two weeks late and turned up on a Monday – these 3 had done Laurel’s beginners class and seen the article in the Post. Therefore, the Post article was most successful of advertising methods used.

7 Promotion

- Flyers – very good but not very successful. Tear off tag flyers more useful – with phone number & website
- Website – please everyone search on Andre workshop and link to our page - **ALL**
 - Modifications agreed necessary (**Jenny C.**):
 - What’s New page should only be “What’s new”
 - Need two new tabs: What dances were taught & Past Events

- Teachers need to let Jenny C. know what they taught (Action, **Palenque** to inform teachers), or **Jenny B.** to email Jenny C. with dance names out of the book
- Newspaper ad: Bev to use \$100 budget for advertisements, any more to discuss with both John's
- Poster for St Marg's noticeboard – **Bev** still working on – **Palenque** to send the dancing figures header we use on flyers to Bev. Photos to be sent by **John W or John B.?**
- Facebook site - Palenque
- PID registration with Western Suburbs Community Directory – complete on the web – Thanks John B.
- Grapevine – for the AGM – **Palenque/Martin?** – to include Dances taught? – Andre summary. Other events

8 Other Business

- PO Box – to keep or not to keep?
 - Not keep, cancel post-Andre, no new one created yet, Ausdance stuff currently going to John, **John** to confirm this is the only address they hold.
- SurveyMonkey survey
 - **Palenque** to action
- Communication: group email addresses & redirects - Jenny C. absent by this time, Bev: gmail not used but can't be deleted
- John raised a need for a guideline regarding PID events and target profit to help cover administration, Insurance and memberships. The guideline is needed to cover events organized under the banner of PID: e.g. teaching at external events (e.g. school teaching, Hills group & workshops): Guideline: events organized under the banner of PID are to return 10% of turnover to PID, unless the event is loss-making or makes a profit of less than a certain amount to the organisers/individual. **John W.** to discuss further, particularly with Jennifer and the hills group, particularly regarding Hills group members becoming members.
- John suggested we organize a "Last 5 Coins party": to include filming, to involve Soulieado, Hora Shalom, Bellydance, 2 or 3 cameras, maybe November, "Coins video shoot". Sell tickets. **John W.** to organize with Coins, 9th or 16th November suggested. Then book hall, **Pat** to talk to Laurel, **Jenny C** to discuss with Hora Shalom. Looking for a person in each group to sell tickets.
