**3 Treasurers Report**

- Draft Annual Report complete for tabling
- This year: Mondays made a small loss (~\$200, \$60 loss for Xmas Party)
- Monday nights attendance sad last week ~8 people
- 38 members this year, more than last year
- Month on month pattern –wildly variable, no particular trend
- Yorgo's workshop lost money (several hundred dollars)
- John and Eve have been donating back teaching fees, \$530 between them
- Saturday group was positive ~\$200
- Cash at year end ~\$4500

- Palenque teaching 'Medieval' dances at the Waldorf/Steiner school to Year 7's over 3 sessions in August. Complete successfully
- Tarantella teaching at Mt Lawley SHS – 3 sessions in September successful – generated more interest.
- National Folk Festival 2014 application(s) – 17-21 April
