## 7 Events coming up

 Sausage sizzle - John B. booked with Bunnings Claremont for Saturday 29th March. John B. to cancel Saturday dancing for 29 March.

Permission to cook on the streets etc received. We need to organise: Eskies, gloves, sauces etc. John B. has started purchasing e.g. drinks. Numbers expected = 250. Encourage people to wear a PID t-shirt on the day. Flyers to hand out at sausage sizzle: John will work on with Bev (1/4 A4 size) – discussed specific edits, including making 'Nedlands' more prominent, removing dates and referring to Introductory courses available. If necessary we can add details of Intro courses etc by hand on the back (with printed stickers), but at least the flyer won't date.
